



BABY CARDIGAN "GUILLE"



Cotton 170 m.- 50 gr. Or fine wool 330 m.-50 gr and large sleeve

Cast on 77 sts on 2 mm needles and make rib 2/2- 1,5 cm. **Change to 2,5 mm needles**

1ª- k1 - k2tog - yo (eyelet) - k11- kfb – pmarker- kfb – k9 – kfb- pm- kfb – k23- kfb – pmarker- kfb – k9 - kfb – pmarker- kfb – k 14

2ª k4 – all purl -k 4

3ª k9 – k2tog- yo (1ª chart row), continue until marker: kfb-pm-kfb(back)- k5 - k2tog- yo- continue until marker: kfb-pm-kfb (sleeve)- k8 - k2tog - yo- k8 – k2tog- yo, continue until marker: kfb-pm-kfb (front)- k5 - k2tog - yo- continue until marker: kfb-pm-kfb (sleeve)- k5- k2tog- yo- knit all

4ª. - k4 – all purl -k 4

Make eyelets every 9

We do these rows following the chart, until have 6 triangles increase to RAGLAN on each side of ever, 19 increase

The next row from the right side is worked as follows: knit and make chart until marker, place the next stitches (until other marker) on a thread for the sleeve, cast on 5 stitches under the sleeve, and make front and repeat other sleeve.

Make once chart, and a continuation we also do the chart below the sleeve, make on 5 sts: k1- k2tog-yo....

Work 11 cm, change to 2 mm needle and make rib 2/2 and bind of

Place the stitches from the thread back on needle

THE PIECE IS NOW MEASURED FROM HERE! Cast on 2 stitches in each side of the sleeve, work once chart, **change to 2 mm** needle and work 1,5 cm rib 2/2.

Bind off. Work the other sleeve in the same way.
